Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 76

A local law creating the Orleans County Traffic Safety Board and establishing its functions (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the (Name of Legislative Body)

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established the Orleans County Traffic Safety Board to be composed of fifteen (15) members interested in traffic safety and traffic problems to be appointed by the Orleans County Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 2. Each member of the Orleans County Traffic Safety Board shall be a resident and qualified elector of the County of Orleans. One member of the Board shall be appointed from each Town of the County and an additional member from each of the incorporated Villages in the County with the balance of the members appointed from the County at large.

SECTION 3. The term of office of each member of the said Board shall be three (3) years excepting that the members first appointed shall be appointed as follows: Five (5) for a term of one (1) year; five (5) for a term of two (2) years and five (5) for a term of three (3) years. Upon the expiration of the term of office of any member, his successor shall be appointed to membership for a term of three (3) years.

SECTION 4. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for services but shall be entitled to reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties within the appropriation made for that purpose and upon proper audit by the Orleans County Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 5. The Orleans County Traffic Safety Board shall meet and organize within fifteen (15) days after the appointment of its members and shall at such organization meeting elect a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary from its members who shall be elected annually thereafter. The said Orleans County Traffic Safety Board shall adopt their own rules for the conduct of their business.

ness and shall render annually to the Orleans County Board of Supervisors a verified account of all of the moneys received and expended by it and shall account for its proceedings and other pertinent matters in such form and manner as may be required by the said Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 6. The Orleans County Traffic Safety Board is hereby authorized to have the following functions:

1. To promote and encourage street and highway traffic safety.
2. To formulate county-wide highway safety programs and coordinate efforts of interested parties and agencies engaged in traffic safety education.
3. To cooperate with local officials within the County of Orleans in the formulation and execution of traffic safety programs and activities.
4. To study traffic conditions on streets and highways within the County of Orleans, study and analyze reports of accidents and causes thereof, and to recommend to the appropriate legislative bodies, departments or commissions, any changes in rules, orders, regulations and existing laws as the Traffic Safety Board may deem advisable.
5. To conduct meetings within the County whenever and wherever the Traffic Safety Board shall deem it advisable and to invite to such meetings parties and agencies, public and private, interested in traffic regulation, control and safety education.
6. To promote safety education for drivers and pedestrians.
7. To obtain and assemble motor vehicle accident data, and to analyze, study and consolidate such data for educational and informational purposes.

SECTION 7. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
