SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, the salaries of the following County employees are raised as follows, per annum, retroactive to January 1, 1977.

Director of Real Property	10,650.00	11,000.00
County Sheriff	15,000.00	16,500.00

SECTION 2. This local law is adopted subject to referendum on petition pursuant to Section 24, Subdivision 2-h of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect 45 days after adoption hereof, or after approval by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the County of Orleans voting on a proposition for its approval, after petition, whichever event first occurs.
