SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, the salaries of the following County employees are raised as follows, per annum, January 1, 1981.

Employee	Present Salary	Proposed Increased Salary
County Treasurer	\$ 17,655	\$ 19,000
District Attorney	23,005	24,500
Public Defender	21,000	22,470
Social Services Commissioner	26,750	28,623
Superintendent of Highways	19,795	21,000
Sheriff	18,725	20,100
Personnel Officer	9,363	9,995

SECTION 2. This local law is adopted subject to referendum on petition pursuant to Section 24, Subdivision 2-h of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect 45 days after adoption hereof, or after approval by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the County of Orleans voting on a proposition for its approval, after petition, whichever event first occurs.


