SECTION 1. TITLE

The title of this Local Law shall be known as "A Local Law designating the Office of Orleans County District Attorney as a Full-Time Position and Establishing the Compensation for a Full-Time Orleans County District Attorney."

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND PURPOSE

The goals of the vigorous prosecution of crime and the protection of victims' rights within the County of Orleans have inspired the enactment of this Local Law. The Legislature of the County of Orleans recognizes that an effective means to achieve these goals is through the designation of the Office of District Attorney of the County of Orleans as a full-time position.

The purpose of the enactment of this Local Law is to designate such office as a full-time position pursuant to Subd. 8 of Sect. 700 of the County Law of the State of New York and to qualify the County of Orleans for the program of state aid as provided for in Sect. 700 of the County Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 3. DESIGNATION AND DUTIES

Pursuant to Subd. 8 of Sect. 700 of the County Law of the State of New York, the Legislature of the County of Orleans hereby designates the Office of District Attorney of the County of Orleans as a full-time position.

The District Attorney of the County of Orleans shall give his whole time to his duties and shall not engage in the practice of law, act as an arbitrator, referee or compensated mediator in any action or proceeding or matter or engage in the conduct of any other profession or business

which interferes with the performance of his duties as District Attorney.

SECTION 4. COMPENSATION

In accordance with the provisions of Sect. 183-a of the Judiciary Law, the District Attorney of Orleans County, the County Legislature of which, by enactment of this Local Law, has designated such Office as a full-time position pursuant to Subd. 8 of Sect. 700 of the County Law of the State of New York, shall receive an annual salary equivalent to that of the Orleans County Court Judge.

SECTION 5

This Local Law is adopted subject to referendum on petition pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect May 1, 1996 or after approval by one affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the County of Orleans voting on a proposition for its approval, after petition, whichever event first occurs.
