A local law Increasing the Maximum Income Eligibility Level for the Senior Citizen Tax Exemption Under Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law

Section 1. This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law and the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the income eligibility levels for determining qualification for the partial exemption from real property taxes for persons sixty-five (65) years of age and older are hereby established in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Annual Income</u>	<u>Percentage Assessed Valuation</u> <u>Exempt From Taxation</u>
\$0 - \$12,500	50%
\$12,501 - \$13,500	45%
\$13,501 - \$14,500	40%
\$14,501 - \$15,500	35%
\$15,501 - \$16,400	30%
\$16,401 - \$17,300	25%
\$17,301 - \$18,200	20%
\$18,201 and over	None

Section 3. All local laws or resolutions, or parts or portions thereof, that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State and shall apply to assessment rolls prepared on the basis of taxable status dates occurring on and after March 1, 2005.
