Local Law Extending the Term of Office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Legislature

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Local Law is to extend the term of office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Orleans County Legislature so that the term of office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Orleans County Legislature shall be for a term expiring with that of their term of office as a County Legislator.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to provisions of Section 151 subdivision (4) of the County Law of the State of New York, the selection of the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman of the Orleans County Legislature shall occur in January of each even numbered year, and the term of office of the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman shall be for a term expiring with that of their term of office as a County Legislator.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the Secretary of State, as required by law.


