A local law to Establish a Boat Launching Fee at the Oak Orchard State

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The County of Orleans has been granted a Special Use Permit by the Genesee State Park Region for the operation of the Oak Orchard State Boat Launch for the period of April 15, 2010 to October 30, 2010. Under the provisions of the Special Use Permit, the County will undertake operation and maintenance of the facility. Revenues generated or collected by the County in the operation of this facility will be used to support the operation and maintenance of the facility. The purpose of this Local Law is to establish a boat launch fee and provide for the enforcement thereof.

SECTION 2. FEES. Any person who launches a boat from the launch ramp shall pay a fee. The boat launching fee per launching shall be in the amount of Six and 00/100 (\$6.00) Dollars. An Empire State Passport may be used in lieu of payment of the fee.

SECTION 3. PENALTY. Any person who launches a boat from the facility without payment of the fee established hereunder shall be subject to a fine of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) per offense.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE. This Local Law shall take effect as provided by law, and if not sooner terminated, shall conclude on October 30, 2010.


