A Local Law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law 3-c for fiscal year 2012

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The slow recovery of the national and state economies and the continued financial obligations imposed on the County of Orleans by New York State in the form of mandated governmental services not fully funded by the State are conditions beyond the control of County government. Notwithstanding these circumstances, the County will need to provide services in 2012, in addition to those mandated by the State, which are important to our citizens.

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the County of Orleans pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the County of Orleans to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2012 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the County of Orleans to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2012 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the county legislature to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the county legislature.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The County Legislature of the County of Orleans, New York, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2012 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise proscribed in General Municipal Law, §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in it separation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
