Mailing items to an inmate

Certain basic necessities can be mailed to inmates that are confined in the Orleans County Jail. All incoming mail and packages are subject to be searched by correctional staff.

The following items may be mailed to the facility:

1. 3 Pairs of socks.
2. 3 pairs of underwear or boxer briefs.
3. 3 T-shirts.
4. 1 pair of sweat pants and sweat shirt.
5. 1 set of thermal underwear.
6. 1 pair of shorts.
7. Female inmates 3 bras (no under-wires)
8. 1 paperback book from the publisher
9. Factory sealed games (no metal pieces)

*Any clothing item(s) mailed to the facility must be white or grey in color.

*Clothing items will not have hoods, zippers, pockets or drawstrings.

*Clothing Items will not have any writing, logos or decals on them.

Stationary and personal hygiene products must be purchased from commissary unless the inmate is indigent.

Any item that is mailed to the facility and is not authorized by the facility will be required to be mailed out at the inmate's expense within 5 business days.
